

Suitcase Sorting Game

Objective: Learn and refine fine motor and handwriting skills, and practice isolating vowel sounds

Why purchase

Materials

Teacher Preparations:

- Collect egg cartons and cut in half (so that you have 6 spaces)
- Place masking tape on bottom for students to write their names
- Prepare working area where children can paint
- Cut the pipe cleaner into approximately 4 inch pieces

Directions:


1. Cover the top and side of the egg carton with masking tape, creating a side with masking tape in the process.
2. Using Prang® Ready-To-Use - Liquid Tempera Paint, paint the top, taped half of the egg carton. Allow to dry.
3. On first index card, write the five vowels and "Game Cards". Then cut to fit in the egg carton.
4. Using a Prang® Glue Stick, glue pieces to the inside of the carton each in a separate space.
5. On second index card, write directions (listed below) to game.

Directions:

- 1) *Player 1 reads word.*
 - 2) *Player 2 repeats word, and then puts into correct place.*
 - 3) *Continue until all cards are done.*
6. Glue directions to inside cover.
 7. On third index card, decorate a cover for the game
 8. Glue cover to top of the egg carton.
 9. On last index card, write a list of short vowel words
 10. Cut index card so that each piece has a separate word listed.
 11. Shape pipe cleaner into suitcase handle. Tape pipe cleaner to side of carton.

Modifications

- Put masking tape on for students.
- Use printed words for students who have trouble writing.
- Other phonetic concepts can also be sorted using this method.
- A whole egg carton can be used, if sorting a variety of phonetic concepts.
- The suitcase can also be used to sort other concepts including: shapes, colors, scientific groups, food groups.
